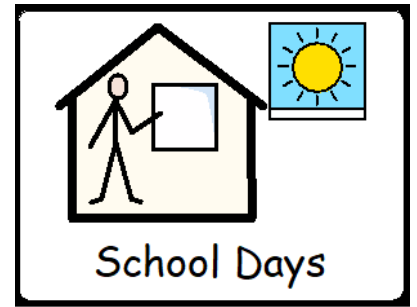








Squirrels Class Blog

Our topic this term is:
School Days



 <p>English</p>	<p>After half term we had a focus on Diwali for a week. We practised mark-making and reading non-fiction text. We then focussed on the stories 'The Day the Crayons Quit', 'Zog' and 'The Christmas Pine'. We have been practising comprehension skills and using colourful semantics to create sentences.</p>
 <p>Maths</p>	<p>In Maths we focussed on addition and subtraction - looking at parts and whole. We have also learnt about time including days of the week, months and time vocabulary.</p>
 <p>Science</p>	<p>In Science we looked at animals and what they eat. We sorted herbivores, carnivores and omnivores. We also went to Peak Wildlife to watch the animals in their habitats. It was amazing!</p>
 <p>History</p>	<p>In History we have been comparing schools from past to present, including our own. We then explored a Victorian Christmas!</p>
 <p>Music</p>	<p>In Music we have been following flashcards to play different instruments and taking turns.</p>

 <p>DT</p>	<p>In DT we looked at playground structures and made our own models for our class toy Cyril the Squirrel.</p>
 <p>French</p>	<p>In French we have been listening to and saying colours and numbers. We've explored France and pictures related to the language</p>
 <p>RE</p>	<p>Our focus question in RE have been: What do Christians learn from the Creation Story? - we explored the stories: the creation story, Adam and Eve, Noah's Ark. What is it like for someone to follow God? - linked to Diwali and Christmas.</p>
 <p>PE</p>	<p>In PE we have been practising our dancing skills. We have also been to Grow Moorlands at John Hall Gardens in small groups to engage in gardening and well-being activities.</p>
