## **Topic - Everyday Life**

We are focusing our activities this term around our topic – Everyday Life. Our Science focus is everyday materials and changing seasons. For English and Phonics, we will be exploring Attention Autism in class and exploring our favourite nursery rhymes, as well as focusing on mark making and fine motor skills. For Maths, we will be exploring our early Maths skills.

#### **Activity One - Nursery rhymes**

## **Activity Two - Exploring sounds**

Create your own instruments at home using household items. This could be saucepans and wooden spoons, metalic household items, making sensory bottles from rice/ pasta, etc.



#### **Activity Three - Autumn walk**

Go on an autumn walk and see what you can hear. Listen to the birds in the trees and the leaves crunching beneath your feet. Splash in muddy puddles! Collect leaves and pinecones and explore their sizes and colours – you could even create a collage or prints of what you find on your walk.



# Activity Four - Turn taking

Practise turn taking with your family and friends. Can you take turns to build a tower using blocks, or roll a ball back and forth? You might even have a favourite game that you like to play or a favourite book that you can share!





## Activity Five - Counting

Explore counting to 10 in different ways. This could be by creating a hopscotch in your garden, bouncing on a trampoline and counting 10 jumps, counting your teddies or toys, etc.



#### Activity Six - Mark making

Practise mark making using a range of mark making tools. This can be paint, crayons, pens, ect. or you could create sensory trays such as flour, rice, sand, etc. and make marks using your fingers. Practise making lines and circles.
