Activity One

Arts and Crafts:

Can you make a pirate boat at home using recycled materials? You could use an empty butter tub or something similar and test to see if it floats!

Activity Two

Fine Motor Skills:

Fishing! Fill a bowl with water and put in some floating objects. Can you use a sieve, strainer or large spoon to scoop out the objects? How many objects can you fish out of the water?

Activity Three

Maths:

Hidden Treasure! What treasures can you find around your home? Collect them up and practise counting and sorting them. You might even try to line them up or stack them too!

Activity Four

Mark Making:

Make a treasure map while exploring different textures. Use a wet teabag to stain a piece of paper (feel the warmth or coldness of the teabag and spread it across the paper). Use any mark making materials to draw on your map once it has dried. Where does your map lead you?

Activity Five

Sensory Activity:

Buried Treasure! Have you got any sand at home (or you could use flour/ cornflour, etc.)? Practise pouring some water and mixing the sand or flour together with the water. What materials/ objects can you find at home to create your own buried treasure? Bury the treasure in the mixture and try to find it again later on.


Activity Six






