

Afternoon Activities

Monday - Make and decorate gingerbread men (see attached recipe).

Tuesday - Make, decorate and taste pancakes (see attached recipe).

Wednesday - Dough disco and playdough with tools.

Thursday - Valentine's Day crafts (decorating heart cut-outs and making a card).

Friday - Chinese New Year crafts (making lanterns and firework pictures).

Fine Motor Activities

Posting and transferring pompoms. You could post pompoms into an empty bottle, transfer them from one bowl to another using your fingers, and then use tweezers/ cooking tongues to transfer them from one bowl to another. You could make this a challenge by using your fingers to transfer the pompoms, but put socks on your hands!

Dough Disco

Start with a warm up for dough disco singing 'Tommy Thumb' and get those fingers moving. Then use your hands and fingers to roll, squeeze, pat, and stretch the play-dough.

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Making Gingerbread Men

See the attached recipe. You will need:

- o 225g plain flour, plus extra for dusting
- o ½ tsp salt
- o 2 tsp bicarbonate of soda
- o 1 heaped tsp ground ginger
- o ½ tsp cinnamon
- o 50g unsalted butter
- o 100g soft brown sugar
- o 100g golden syrup

Gingerbread men

On a surface lightly dusted with flour, roll out the dough to a ¼-inch thickness. Stamp out the gingerbread men shapes with a cutter, then re-roll any off-cuts and repeat. Place your gingerbread shapes on the lined trays, allowing space for them to spread.

Making and Decorating Pancakes

See the attached recipe. You will need:

- 100g plain flour
- 2 large eggs
- 300ml milk
- 1 tbsp sunflower/vegetable oil or butter, plus a little extra for frying

Practise your measuring skills with the ingredients, your mixing skills with a spoon or whisk, and your flipping skills with a spatula and pan... Don't forget to decorate and taste them!

Easy pancakes

Ingredients STEP 1 Put 100g plain flour, 2 large eggs, 300ml milk, 1 tbsp sunflower or vegetable oil and a pinch of salt into a bowl or large jug, then whisk to a smooth batter. STEP 2 Set aside for 30 mins to rest if you have time, or start cooking straight away.

Mark Making Activities

Monday and Wednesday - practise drawing **circles** with **crayons** and **felt tips**.

Tuesday - **cut out circles** to represent pancakes and decorate them using any **pens**, **pencils**, etc.

Thursday - **Cut out a heart** shape and **dab paint** onto it. **Fold it in half** down the middle to create a symmetrical pattern.

Friday - Use lots of **bright colours** and **squiggly lines** to represent the **chinese dragon**.
