They are linked to our topic work at school and may prompt your child to talk about what we have been learning about at school. All home challenges will be presented and discussed weekly, on a Friday morning.

<p>Week beginning 9.1.23</p>	<p><b>Topic - A Journey through Europe</b></p> <p>What do you already know about a country in Europe or on the European continent?</p> <p>What facts about your chosen country to start this new and exciting topic.</p>
<p>Week beginning 16.1.23</p>	<p><b>Maths - Shape (2D and 3D shapes)</b></p> <p>What shapes can you see around the house?</p> <p>Can you identify real objects that are 2D and/or 3D shapes?</p> <p>Write a list of what you can find or send pictures to the class email.</p>
<p>Week beginning 23.1.23</p>	<p><b>Chinese New Year - Year of the Rabbit</b></p> <p>It's 2023 and the year of the rabbit.</p> <p>Have a go at drawing your own rabbit and researching and retelling the Chinese New Year story.</p>
<p>Week beginning 30.1.23</p>	<p><b>Science - Earth and Space</b></p> <p>Can you create your own 'mnemonic' - a way of remembering the order of the planets? Something like this...</p> <p>My (Mercury) Very (Venus) Easy (Earth) Method (Mars) Just (Jupiter) Speeds (Saturn) Up (Uranus) Nothing (Neptune)</p> <p>How silly could your mnemonic be?</p>
<p>Week beginning 6.2.23</p>	<p><b>Independence - dressing, zipping clothes and tying shoe laces.</b></p> <p>Explore the opportunities to continue with or begin to zip your own coats and tie shoes laces. Let me know how you get on. Sometimes, this is not an easy task. This is lots and lots of practice.</p>
<p>Week beginning 13.2.23</p>	<p><b>English - Poetry and rhyming words</b></p> <p>We recapped and focused on rhyming words and poetry. Have a go at creating your own short rhyme about something that you like or your favourite thing.</p> <p>You could also spend time with your adult finding rhyming words. Give your adult a word and see if they can match it with a rhyming word.</p>
