Our topic this term is: Toys

Our focus this week is: [The Brampton Museum](#)

Monday	This morning we did Geography - exploring the continents of the world. We also did French - counting to 10. In the afternoon we prepared for our trip to Brampton. We looked at photos and videos and also played with role-play toys linked to the story 'Naughty Bus'.
Tuesday	Today we went to Brampton Museum. So much fun and learning! We went on a Story World Adventure of 'Major Glad, Major Dizzy' by Jan Oke. We created a toy for William using junk modelling, ordered events on a time line, played with some of Amelia's old fashioned toys, went on a Teddy Bear Hunt in the old shop set, looked at old toys in the cupboards and finally went to the cellar to look at how a maid would do their washing.
Wednesday	In English we sequenced the trip day using photos and time connectives (first, next, then, after, finally). In Maths we added numbers using numicon and the part-whole model. In the afternoon we did dancing in PE using ribbons and pom poms.
Thursday	In English we wrote about our trip. In Maths we added using pictures of numicon or counters. In the afternoon we did DT - we created a salt-dough fossil toy.
Friday	This morning we did our weekly phonics assessments. We also did our 2 minutes silence for Armistice Day and created a poppy biscuit. In the afternoon it was choice. We also counted our Springfield Pounds and decided whether to save or spend.
