INTENT

Aims & Objectives:

To develop children's interest, confidence and skills in understanding and speaking in a foreign language and where appropriate writing or recording.

Objectives:

- To introduce children to languages in a fun interactive way using a multi-sensory approach where appropriate.
- To make children aware that language has structure and that the structure varies from one language to another.
- To make children aware of cultural differences in other countries.
- To develop their speaking and listening skills in English and the target language
- To lay the foundations for further study

During Reception and Key Stage 1 pupils will have access to at least one 'Wow' day focussing on another country, it's customs, culture and language.



